

Downtown Small Area Study Advisory Committee

Meeting Minutes – March 18, 2008

The Downtown Small Area Study Advisory Committee met on March 18, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. in the Municipal Center Council Chambers. Mayor Moriconi welcomed everyone to this orientation meeting and thanked the committee members for volunteering to serve the City in this capacity. He advised that this meeting would be informational in that Keith Logsdon and Emalee Listermann, staff members of the Northern Kentucky Area Planning Commission would provide an overview of the results of the Downtown Study and give them some direction regarding the roles and responsibilities expected of this committee.

For the remainder of the meeting, Mayor Moriconi yielded the floor to Mr. Logsdon and Ms. Listermann. Ms. Listermann was the Project Manager for the Downtown Study. The committee members introduced themselves to everyone. The committee members include:

Mr. Logsdon explained the function of the Northern Kentucky Area Planning Commission, the 5-year Comprehensive Plan and the process that was taken to conduct the Downtown Small Area Study.

Mr. Logsdon advised they would assist this Committee in getting established and would provide agendas and conduct the first four meetings, so that they would be operational after that time. He assured the Committee that they would be available for assistance anytime the need arises.

Ms. Listermann presented a power point presentation of the Small Area Study and provided her perspective of what is expected from this committee. She suggested upcoming meetings that may be of interest to the committee members, specifically a meeting to be held at Simon Kenton High School on the evening of June 12th and all day on June 13, 2008, which is a workshop on "Traditional Neighborhood Development" and will be sponsored by the Kenton County Health Department.

Ms. Listermann reviewed Municipal Order No. 2008-MO-01 which established this Committee and pointed out that that the municipal order states that the Committee should meet a minimum of four times each year.

In closing the meeting, the Committee scheduled the next four meetings to be April 17, May 15, June 19 and July 17. All meetings will be held at the Senior/Community Center.

There being no further assistance, the meeting adjourned at 7:38 p.m.
