

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-O-18

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING COVID-19 RELIEF TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS OF INDEPENDENCE BY PROVIDING A ONE TIME REDUCTION OF 10 PERCENT OFF THEIR ENTIRE REAL ESTATE PROPERTY TAX BILL FOR REAL PROPERTY TAX BILLS ISSUED IN OCTOBER 2021 AND PAID PRIOR TO DECEMBER 31, 2021

WHEREAS, the property owners of Independence have had economic hardship due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Independence wishes to provide a one time, rebate to property owners amounting to ten (10) percent of their overall real estate bill; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That the City of Independence does hereby provide a ten (10) percent reduction for real estate property tax bills, mailed in October of 2021, if paid by December 31, 2021. The ten (10) percent reduction shall not be applicable for any other tax years and for late payments. This shall be a separate line item in the City of Independence budget and will have no impact on the rate calculations under KRS 132.

SECTION II

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication, and recording, according to law.
