

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-O-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE'S CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO SECTION 94.02 AND ALLOWING CERTAIN CITY PARKS WITH LIGHTING TO BE PARTIALLY OPEN AFTER DARK

WHEREAS, The City of Independence has made significant improvements to Memorial Park by adding lighted pickleball and basketball courts; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is being adopted to Amend Chapter 94.02 of the Code of Ordinances to allow the use of the lighted facilities after dark; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, COUNTY OF KENTON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

§ 94.02 CLOSING TIME FOR PARKS.


All city parks, recreational areas, and ballfields in the city shall be closed at dark except areas lighted specifically for basketball, pickleball and city sponsored events.


SECTION II

That any section, or part of any section, or any provision of this Ordinance which is declared invalid by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
