Proclamation

City of Independence, Kentucky

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Independence are committed to the health and well-being of our community;

WHEREAS, Parkinson's disease is a chronic, progressive, neurological disease, is the second most common neurodegenerative disease in the United States and the 14th leading cause of death in our nation according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and

WHEREAS, Parkinson's disease is estimated to affect approximately one million people in the United States and the prevalence will more than double by 2040; and

WHEREAS, research suggests the cause of Parkinson's disease is a combination of genetic and environmental factors, but the exact cause and progression of the disease is still unknown and there is no cure or drug to slow or halt its progression; and

WHEREAS, the symptoms of Parkinson's disease vary from person to person and can include tremors; slowness of movement and rigidity; difficulty with balance, swallowing, chewing, and speaking; cognitive impairment and dementia; mood disorders; and a variety of other non-motor symptoms; and

WHEREAS, increased research, education, and community support services such as those provided by the Parkinson's Foundation and other organizations are needed to find more effective treatments and to provide access to quality care to those living with the disease today; and

WHEREAS, the Independence area's own Buckeye Dave Shields and his band, White Liger, continue to make strides locally toward Parkinson's awareness and fundraising through the Rock on the James benefit concert, which will be held on April 27th this year at Southgate House Revival and will be prefaced with a special ROTJ/Parkinson Support & Wellness Night at Independence's own Crewitt's Creek Kitchen & Bar on April 10th and Madison Pike Yoga every Sunday in April;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Christopher J. Reinersman, Mayor of Independence, on behalf of the City Council and the citizens of Independence, declare the entire month of April, 2019 as ***PARKINSON'S DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH*** in the City of Independence, and I call this observance to the attention of all our citizens. I further declare White Liger to be the best band to come out of Independence with a demonstrated commitment to fighting Parkinson's disease.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO RENEW A PREVIOUSLY BID CONTRACT WITH MALCO LAWN SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Independence, Kentucky, Kenton County, Kentucky, previously issued a Request for Proposals for mowing and general maintenance within the City.

WHEREAS, the City of Independence, Kentucky, Kenton County Kentucky, included in the bid that each vendor was to provide pricing for term extensions and each vendor did provide future pricing.

WHEREAS, The City's Administrative Staff has been advised that Malco Lawn Services is desirous of extending the term of its contract for mowing and general maintenance, for the price set forth in its prior bid.
