**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTUCKY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-O-05 AND THE ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED THEREBY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2022 BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF CITY GOVERNMENT, INCORPORATING LINE ITEMS, AND PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.**

**WHEREAS**, an amending budget proposal and message have been prepared and delivered to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed such amended budget and made necessary modifications.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I**

That the amended annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 is hereby adopted as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, THEREBY ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2023, BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT, INCORPORATING LINE ITEMS, AND PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I**

Pursuant to the requirements of KRS 91A.030(10), the City of Independence shall during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 operate and be operated pursuant to the line item budget set forth in Section II and no monies shall be expended by or on behalf of the City of Independence except in accordance therewith.

**SECTION II**

The annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023 is as follows:

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-O-**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY,  
ENACTING A PERSONNEL AND PAY CLASSIFICATION PLAN PURSUANT TO KRS  
83A.070(3).**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE IN  
KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Independence maintains job descriptions and a pay scale for its employees in accordance with its annual budget, and

**WHEREAS**, KRS 83A.070 requires the legislative body of each city to adopt by ordinance personnel and pay classification plan, it is hereby ordained as follows:

**SECTION I**

The Personnel and Pay Classification Plan attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A", sets forth the job title and pay scale for each employment position of the City of Independence, which have been developed and authorized in accordance with the City's annual budget previously adopted by ordinance.

**SECTION II**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

**SECTION III**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION IV**

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

**SECTION V**

This ordinance shall be published in summary pursuant to KRS 83A.060(9)
