On Friday, March 1, 2019 at 11:00 AM, Bid Proposals were opened for the above-referenced project. There were a total of two (2) Bid Proposals received; the results were as follows:

<u>BIDDER</u>	<u>TOTAL AMOUNT BID</u>
JPS Construction	\$385,600.00
TMS Construction	\$409,860.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$379,200.00

Based upon the outcome of the bid opening and our review of the bids received, it is our recommendation that the Contract be awarded to JPS Construction in the amount of \$385,600.00 (which is the total amount bid), pending approval of all paperwork by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.

Per the agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, the city will be reimbursed a total of \$250,000.00 for this project.
