RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-12

A RESOLUTION SPONSORING A PROPOSED TEXT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, KRS 100.211(3) provides that a proposal for a text amendment may originate with the legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky legislature has authorized cities to regulate medical cannabis; and

WHEREAS, the Independence City Council would like PDS staff to research and issue recommendations and to move forward with a hearing in front of the Kenton County Planning Commission for the regulation of medical cannabis through zoning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, COUNTY OF KENTON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THAT:

The City Administrator, as an agent of the City's legislative body, is authorized to apply and propose the following to be studied and set for public hearing pursuant to KRS 200.211:

Medical Cannabis as permitted uses pursuant to the attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein by reference.
